AND OF THE GENERAL ALARM BELLS FOR A
PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN TEN SECONDS.

ABANDON SHIP

MORE THAN SIX SHORT BLASTS AND ONE LONG
BLAST OF THE WHISTLE SUPPLEMENTED BY THE
SAME SIGNAL ON THE GENERAL ALARM BELLS.

LIFE PRESERVERS

LIFE PRESERVERS TO BE FOUND IN RACKS, UNDER
BUNKS, OR ON BULKHEADS. PASSENGERS AND
CREW WILL OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES:

TO ADJUST LIFE PRESERVERS SLIP THE PRESERVERS ON LIKE A JACKET, FASTEN CHEST STRAP
SNAP HOOK AND TIE AT THE COLLAR, NECK,
AND WAIST.

ALL PASSENGERS MUST PUT ON LIFE PRESERVERS
WHENEVER GENERAL ALARM BELL RINGS.

PASSENGERS PARTICIPATE ONLY IN ABANDON
SHIP DRILL, DURING OTHER DRILLS STAND FAST,
LEAVE PASSAGeways CLEAR.

LIFE PRESERVERS FOR CHILDREN TO BE OBTAINED
FROM THE COMMANDING OFFICER, MILITARY
DEPARTMENT, AFTER EMBARKING.
