1. The Fire Drill was a simulated Class "A" fire in ships' officers' lounge 01-93-0-1. Repair I was dispatched to the scene and extinguished the fire with water from two 1 1/2 inch hoses.

2. Deficiencies:

- One four foot low velocity applicator in D.C. locker was defective.
- Zone personnel required prompting to lead out hoses.
- Closures were not complete.
- OBA men require more instruction in use of OBA.

3. During the Boat Drill all starboard boats with the exception of #9 were waterborne.

4. Deficiencies:

- Blankets were not placed in boats.
- Boat #1 - Boat hooks were not used to fend off; rudder was shipped after boat was waterborne.
- Boat #3 - Bow and stern tender did not ride the boat down the trackway; only one boat hook was used to fend off; boat Commander was not familiar with the flemming gear.
- Boat #5A - Sweep oar was neither readied nor used; rudder was missing a pintle bar;
Boat #5 - Boat hooks weren't used to fend off.
