1. In reply to reference (a), the quantities of clocks allowed in Part II, Group S24-5, Page 1, Line 9 and the office machine allowed in Part II, Group 32-2, Page 1 of reference (b) are the same as those allowed for similar type ships, both USNS and USS. To date these quantities have proven satisfactory.

2. If, upon completion of the first voyage, the Master still feels these quantities are inadequate for his operation, he may re-submit his request for in-excess quantities together with complete justification for his requirements.

3. Note (c) at the bottom of Page 1, Group S32-2, Part II of reference (b) states that 11" typewriters may be substituted for 15" machines where required.
