Subj: Safety meeting

1. Safety meeting for the Engine Department personnel was called to order at 1130, 11 June 1969, with the First Assistant Engineer Mr. Allen S. Corbin, presiding. Twenty (20) men were present.
2. The minutes of the last meeting were read and discussed. No deficiencies reported last meeting and no accidents reported.
3. Personnel were told to put oily and dirty rags in covered cans provided for it. Light cords are tripping hazards, look for it.
4. An article entitled, "USE AIR WITH CARE IN PAINT TEST", published by Safety Newsletter, Marine Section, National Safety Council, issue of March 1969, was read and discussed, also articles published by Coast Guard Proceedings of the Merchant Marine Council, entitled, "DON'T LET YOUR FLEET KILL YOU", and "ONLY A MILE AWAY", were read and discussed. Prevention of poisoning was also discussed.
5. Personnel were cautioned not to enter tanks if they are not sure of being gas free, use OSA if in doubt and never go into a tank without assistance.
6. Shaft Alley Door is under repair and must remain closed. Use escape trunk for daily inspection of Shaft Alley.
7. Meeting was adjourned at 1210.
