Title: Protection For You was given.

4. Principle topics discussed, safety suggestion made and safety hazards noted are as follows:

(a.) The Government and Commercial companies has all kinds of protective equipment available for any hazardous job that is to be done, however we can't stand beside you to see that you wear goggles, safety shields, safety shoes and ect. It is your eyes, face or other parts of your body that needs protection, not the Master of the ship or the President of the company, so the equipment wont protect you if you don't wear them. Wear the protective equipment that the job requires thereby keeping the safe door locked against the accidents that might happen to you.

(b.) Accident reporting and be sure to get a (NAVEXOS-107) Dispensary permit from your supervisor so that there will be no repercussion in the future.

(c.) Be on the alert while on the beach. Don't drink to excess, if you drink don't drive. "The life that you save may be your own."

(d.) There was a short discussion on Moral Leadership.
