THE LADDERS AT BOAT NO. 1 & 2 SHOULD BE IN PLACE AT ALL TIMES.

MR. BURNEY STRESSED THE REASONS WHY BOATS SHOULD NOT BE OCCUPIED BY ANY PERSONNEL WHILE BOATS ARE RIDING ON TRACKS DURING BOAT DRILLS.
