Subj: LEGER, James L., US-55834000, E-2, USA, 25th Admin. Co;
report of injury to.

1. The subject named man was injured at 1020 on 8 March 1966.
2. Diagnosis: Wound Lacerated left eyebrow
3. Within command, not work, not due to own misconduct.
4. Patient was sitting in corner of ladder well 3-2. He started to get up and felt rather faint. This was the last thing he remembered. After regain consciousness he found that he had struck his head when he fell.
5. Treatment: Area shaved and cleansed with phisohex, then irrigated with saline solution. Area anesthetized with 2% Lidocaine, 5 3-0 Chromic suture: applied subcutaneously, and 5 4-0 silk sutures were put in the skin. X-rays were taken, and 0.5 cc Tetanus Toxoid was administered.
6. Disposition: Bed rest for remainder of day. Bridge notified at 1120.
