1. The subject named man was injured at 1330 on 8 February 1966.
2. Diagnosis: 2" laceration of right hand.
3. Within command, work, not due to own misconduct.
4. Patient was loading boxes of chicken into a LCM when his hand slipped and was cut by a wire on the box.
5. Treatment: Cleansed with Phisohex, Lidocaine was used to anesthetize the area, and laceration was closed with four sutures of 4-0 silk, then the area was covered with sterile 4 x 4 bandages and wrapped with a elastic bandage.
6. Disposition: Limited duty until returned to own Unit for evaluation of duty status.
