1. The subject named man was injured at 2030 on 18 January 1966
2. Diagnosis: Burn right hand, second degree.
3. Patient was moving a bucket of hot black oil from underneath air box in forward engine room when ship roll caused the oil to spill on his hand.
4. Treatment: Area cleaned of oil by removing skin to which oil had adhered. Phisohex was used to scrub around wound. Furacin gauze was applied and the hand wrapped in sterile gauze.
5. Disposition: To rest in quarters for ten hours and return daily through course of healing for dressing changes and observation.
