2. Diagnosis: Wound, Lacerated, Left Anterior Scalp

5. The patient states that he struck his head against the corner of a fuse box located at Compartment 2-7 on the after bulkhead.
6. Treatment: Cleaned, shaved, sutured with 4-0 silk suture, and dressed with Collodion patch. Tetanus booster administered.
7. Disposition: To duty, to return for recheck as necessary.
