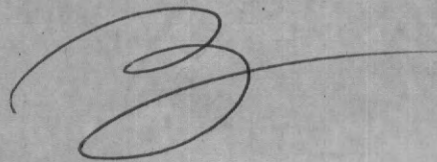

Footnotes

- (a) Any nonwatchstanding licensed deck officer, excluding the Master, who during the course of a voyage is required to stand regular watches will receive penalty time for sea watches stood on Saturdays and Sundays and overtime for such watches stood on holidays.
- (b) Any nonwatchstanding licensed assistant engineer who during the course of a voyage is required to stand regular watches will receive penalty time for sea watches stood on Saturdays and Sundays and overtime for such watches stood on holidays.
- (c) When any nonofficer personnel of the Engine Department in the rating of Fireman (Oil), Watertender, Fireman-Watertender, Evaporator-Utilityman, Oiler, Oiler (Diesel), Refrigeration Oiler, Unlicensed Junior Engineer (watch), any watch electrician rating, or any watch refrigeration engineer rating is assigned to day work at sea or in port without change in rating title; he shall be paid additional compensation at the rate of \$60.00 per month during the period of such assignment to day work.
- (d) For the performance of daily auto alarm tests at sea and daily radio station tests at sea, the radio officer on all ships carrying one radio officer shall receive \$24.00 per month. On ships where more than one radio officer
