1. References (a) and (b), Atlantic Schedules, and references (c) and (d), Pacific Schedules, are further amended to establish definite premium pay rates to Chief Engineers in lieu of compensatory time off. These rates supersede the previously authorized cash payments equivalent to base pay under these circumstances.
2. To effect such changes, enclosures (1) through (4) will replace the applicable existing pages of references (a) through (d) and the new page number 29 of enclosure (1) will be inserted.
3. In connection with the above, the following pen and ink changes will be made to reference (e):
 - a. CMPI 610.3-1c. In the 16th line delete the words "base pay" and substitute "pay the pertinent special rate specified in the applicable schedule of wages".



for ratings carrying base pay rates of less than \$6232 per annum, excluding the rating of Assistant Cook (Fgtr.) and Yeoman-Storekeeper, overtime rate is \$2.46 per hour.

for ratings carrying base pay rates of \$6232 or more per annum, and for the rating of Assistant Cook (Fgtr.) and Yeoman-Storekeeper, overtime is \$3.25 per hour.

Eff. 16 Jun 1966:

for ratings carrying base pay rates of less than \$6475 per annum, excluding the rating of Assistant Cook (Fgtr.) and Yeoman-Storekeeper, overtime rate is \$2.46 per hour.

for ratings carrying base pay rates of \$6475 or more per annum, and for the rating of Assistant Cook (Fgtr.) and Yeoman-Storekeeper, overtime is \$3.25 per hour.

B. Cargo and tank cleaning rates for all nonofficer ratings including Steward Department officers shall be as indicated in CMPI 610.

C. Rates for cash payment in lieu of compensatory time to Chief Engineers in tankers, pursuant to CMPI 610.7-1d effective 1 June 1967.
