1. References (a) and (b) are further amended to establish the officer rating and pay rates for Nurse (special project) in the Medical Department of the Pacific and Atlantic Schedules of Wages. Enclosures (1) and (2) are to be substituted for the applicable existing pages of references (a) and (b).

2. Pending a revision to references (c) and (d) the following hours of work are applicable to the position of Nurse (special project):

a. Hours of work in port. -Both Coasts- Overtime shall be paid for work performed in excess of 8 hours per day, for work performed between 1700 and 0800, Monday through Friday, and for all work performed on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

b. Hours of work at sea. - Pacific Schedule. - Overtime shall be paid for work performed in excess of 8 hours in a spread of 12 Monday through Saturday and for all work on Sundays and holidays. If required to work on Saturday penalty time shall be paid for the 8 hours in a spread of 12 and overtime for work outside the spread or in excess of eight hours.

c. Hours of work at sea. - Atlantic Schedule. - Overtime shall be paid for work performed in excess of 8 hours in a spread of 12 Monday through Friday and for all work on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

(d) For computing the amount due for a fraction of a month, the monthly additional compensations provided in footnotes (a), (b) and (c) above shall be prorated on the basis of a 30-day month; and, for a full pay period or a fraction of a pay period, they are computed in the same manner as base pay except that any fraction of a day counts as a whole day.

II. PREMIUM PAY RATES APPLICABLE TO PROVISIONS OF CMPI'S

Effective as indicated, the authorized premium pay rates for marine ratings covered by this schedule are as follows:

A. OVERTIME AND PENALTY TIME

1. Deck Department officer ratings (excluding radio officer ratings)

Eff. 16 Jun 1965, overtime rate is \$4.23 per hour  
Eff. 16 Nov 1965, penalty time rate is \$3.50 per hour

2. Radio officer ratings

Eff. 16 Jun 1965, overtime rate is \$4.23 per hour  
Eff. 16 Sep 1965, penalty time rate is \$3.50 per hour

3. Engine Department officer ratings

Eff. 16 Jun 1963, overtime rate is \$4.23 per hour  
Eff. 16 Sep 1965, penalty time rate is \$3.50 per hour

4. Purser Department officer ratings

Eff. 16 Jun 1964, overtime rate is \$4.23 per hour  
Eff. 16 Jun 1964, penalty time rate is \$2.80 per hour

5. Nonofficer ratings of the Deck, Engine, Purser, and Medical Departments, for the rating of Nurse, but excluding that of Nurse (special project) and for all ratings of the Steward Department (excluding Chief Steward, Class A-3 and P2-S1-DN3 type ships) effective 16 Jun 1962.

Overtime rates for ratings carrying base pay rate of less than \$4562 per annum -----	\$1.89 per hour
\$4562 per annum but not in excess of \$5309 per annum-----	\$2.42 per hour
\$5310 per annum or more -----	\$2.47 per hour
