Subject: Standing Orders for Watch Officers in Port.

Ref: (a) COMSTS. INST. P3120.2C

Part 2 Chapter 2 of Ref.(a) outlines the general duties and responsibilities of Deck Officers both at sea and in port. Deck Officers will be familiar with the requirements of ref.(a) as regards their duties in port and in addition to these requirements all Deck Officers will strictly comply with the below listed Standing Orders.

a. Watch Officer will insure that there is a proper gangway watch at all times.

b. The Watch Officer will insure that the Quartermaster is alert and attentive to his duties as spelled out in Ships Instructions.

c. The Watch Officer will familiarize himself with the nearest fire alarm Box, and the phone number of the local Fire-Department.

d. The Watch Officer will personally check all Mooring Lines at least every four(4) hours, especially at each change of the tide and prior to high water. He will see that Rat guards are properly on all lines and that lines are not chaffing.

e. The Watch Officer will keep close watch on cargo operations and will comply with "Standing Orders for Cargo Operations."

f. The Watch Officer will make at least one complete round of the ship every four(4) hours to make sure all is secure. During this tour he will be alert for Fire Hazards, and insure that all is in good order.

g. When there are two Officers on Watch, one will normally be at the Deck, except when the Ship is at Anchor, when he will be on the Bridge.

h. When the Ship is at Anchor, Bearings will be checked at least every hour and at each change of the Tide.

i. The Watch Officer will make sure Side-Port doors will be closed and remain clear before permission is granted to open same. He will make sure that they are open all the way or completely closed at all times.

j. The Watch Officer will remain alert and awake at all times and insure that personnel on watch are the same.

k. If at the change of the watch unlicensed personnel do not report for watch he will not allow the person going off watch to do so until his proper relief reports for duty.

l. He will allow no exchanging of the watches by unlicensed personnel without permission of the First Officer, except in cases of emergency.

m. He will allow no unlicensed personnel to relieve the watch who in his opinion is apparently under the influence of intoxicants.

n. Whenever in doubt, call the First Officer or Master Immediately. Always keep in mind that you will be held at fault if you do not know the answer to a particular problem, but you can be held criminally responsible if you attempt to blunder your way through without asking.

Subj: Standing orders for night relief officers

1. The USNS GENERAL POPE and GENERAL WEIGEL are now in RRS 10 Day Status. POPE has been designated by COMSTSPAC as the Mothership with a forty-eight (48) man crew and Night Relief Officers assigned to maintain both ships while in this status. The Night Relief Officers assigned to the POPE will have a dual responsibility to maintain a Fire and Security Watch for both the POPE and WEIGEL.
2. The Security watch for POPE and WEIGEL will consist of:
 - a. Deck Relief Officer
 - b. Engine Relief Officer
 - c. Able Seaman, Gangway Watch on POPE
 - d. Able Seaman, Fire Watch, both ships
3. The R.D.O. will make regular rounds of both vessels. The R.D.O. will ensure that the Gangway watch on USNS POPE is kept informed of his whereabouts at all times during the watch.
4. The Engine Relief Officer will make rounds of engineering areas of both ships according to Chief Engineer's Night Orders.
5. The Able Seaman assigned to Gangway watch will remain on USNS POPE, being alert for ringing of fire system alarm bells for both ships, located at the gangway, USNS POPE. Any sounding of these alarm bells will be investigated immediately.
6. The Able Seaman assigned to the Fire watch will make rounds of both ships, punching the Detex Clock stations.
7. Appropriate entries will be made in POPE's Log showing that the above orders are complied with and a statement made as to the condition of each ship upon completion of rounds made by the Deck Relief Officer.
8. The draft readings on POPE and WEIGEL and the sounding of POPE and WEIGEL will be entered daily in POPE's data log sheet.
9. The temporary door at WEIGEL's sideport gangway will be secured during periods when no one is aboard WEIGEL making rounds of the ship. There will be absolutely no visitors allowed aboard POPE or WEIGEL at anytime.

10. The Deck Relief Officer will be notified by the Gangway Watch on POPE when either the Fire Watch or the Security Watch do not return to POPE from their rounds in a reasonable length of time.
11. IN CASE OF ANY EMERGENCY YOU WILL NOTIFY THE MASTER IMMEDIATELY. Phone numbers for all crew members are at the gangway.
12. There will be no smoking allowed at any time in any area of USNS WEIGEL. There will be no smoking allowed in Troop compartments or storage areas of USNS
13. W.T. Doors are to be kept closed at all times on both ships except when required to be open for maintenance purposes.
14. Weather deck doors on both ships are to be kept closed.
15. Fire screen doors on USNS WEIGEL are to be kept closed at all times
16. Each day on the first round of the 0800-1200 watch, blower motors of the smoke detecting system are to be shifted on both ships.
