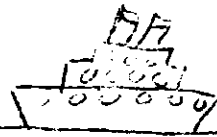

2. SDO AND SDNCO: Report to the Troop Adjutant in the troop office at 1500 hours on the day scheduled for duty. Tour of duty is from 1530 to 0800.

3. OFFICER OF THE GUARD: Report to the Provost Marshal in the troop office at 1600 hours on the day prior to duty for a briefing on the guard duties.

4. MAIL: Mail addressed to a CONUS or APO address is forwarded without stamps. In a person's own handwriting and in ink, write the word "FREE" in the upper right hand corner of the envelope. A military return address must be placed in the upper left hand corner of the envelope. Mail addressed to other than CONUS or an APO will require postage to be determined by an APO agent. "Free" mail may be placed in mail drops aboard ship and it will be forwarded from Vung Tau, Vietnam.

5. DEBARKATION: Following the debark of units at Vung Tau, personnel remaining in compartments will be moved into cabins. After this has been accomplished, the 4th deck level and troop heads will be "OFF LIMITS" to all passengers.

6. SENIOR UNIT COMMANDER: 2LT Phillip C. Long will be Senior Unit Commander after the Vung Tau debarkation.

7. SHIP'S SOP: Members of the voyage staff and other personnel who have copies of the ship's SOP will turn them into the troop office NLT 1600 hours today.

8. TROOP PLAN OF THE DAY:

0400 - Relief change on guard.
0500 - Reveille for all troops.
0530 - Troop chow - breakfast.
0730 - Draw cleaning equipment. Clean up ship.
0800 - Relief change on guard.
1000 - Inspection of all troop spaces.
1130 - Troop chow - dinner.
1200 - Relief change on guard.
1600 - Relief change on guard.
1630 - Troop chow - supper.
2000 - Relief change on guard.
2030 - Draw cleaning equipment. Sweep down compartments and latrines.
2130 - Inspection of all troop spaces.
2300 - Taps. Lights out in all compartments.
2400 - Relief change on guard.
