FREQUENCY - $\frac{\text{TOTAL LOST TIME ACCIDENTS} \times 1,000,000}{\text{TOTAL HOURS WORKED}}$

DWI - DISABLING WORK INJURIES
(REF. CMP 190.1-6 c)

SEVERITY - $\frac{\text{TOTAL DAYS LOST} \times 1,000,000}{\text{TOTAL HOURS WORKED}}$

1. Accident frequency rate based on number of lost time accidents.
2. Degree of supervisory failure related to each lost time accident, graded on a scale of 0 to 10.
3. Proper completion and prompt submission of accident reports which includes NavExos 107, NavExos 108, CA-1 and CA-2.
4. Number of unsafe conditions existing at the Formal Administrative and Independent Safety Inspections.
5. Safety interest as indicated in minutes of Safety Committee.

USNS GAFFEY

1. Steward Dept: Failure to use ladder handrails.

USNS UPSHUR

1. Deck Dept: Failure to use appropriate foot wear.

USNS GORDON

1. Steward Dept: Failure to look where stepping.
2. Steward Dept: Failure to use handrail on ladder.

USNS WEIGEL

1. Deck Dept: Failure to secure hatch cover open with locking pin.
2. Steward Dept: Failure to exercise caution walking on wet deck in scullery.

SPECIAL PROJECT SHIPS

USNS RANGE TRACKER

1. Steward Dept: Failure to use handrails.
2. Deck Dept: Failure to use handrails.

USNS LONGVIEW

1. Engine Dept: Failure to properly drain feed pump prior to repositioning pistons.

CARGO SHIPS

USNS POINT CRUZ

1. Steward Dept: Failure to obtain assistance in lifting heavy garbage can.

USNS CORE

1. Deck Dept: Failure to enforce contractor's liability for safety.

CARGO SHIPS, Cont'd

USNS KIMBRO

1. Deck Dept: Failure to obtain assistance in releasing ship's rigging.

USNS BLAND

1. Engine Dept: Failure to secure material in vertical position.

ADMINISTRATION

M & R Shop

1. Welder: Failure to wear gloves.

EMPLOYMENT OFFICE

1. Jr. Engineer: Failure to exercise caution using emery wheel grinder.
