CHIEF BUTCHER JOB INSTRUCTIONS

1. Assume the supervision of the Butcher Shop and all personnel assigned to it. Assign the duties of the 2nd & 3rd Butchers, and Troop details.
2. Observe all safety rules and regulations and insist that all personnel working in your work areas obey such orders.
3. Enforce the NO SMOKING regulations in your working spaces.
4. Keep physically clean and wear the prescribed uniform when on duty. See that all men working with you observe similar regulations.
5. All unauthorized personnel not to enter the Butcher Shop.
6. Troop will not be permitted to operate power-driven machinery.
7. Make no changes in menu without instruction from the Chief Steward.
8. Observe economies whenever possible.
9. Check the quality and quantity of incoming Stores to see that items are in correct description and amount. Supervise the loading and stowing of all meats, poultry and fish.
10. Rotate stores at specified times, making certain oldest stocks are used conditions demand it.
11. Assume full responsibility for the security, cleanliness and maintenance of the Butcher Shop and connected areas.
12. Report all deficiencies to proper authorities.
13. Maintain the following equipment:

- a. Meat Saw
- b. Tenderizer
- c. Meat Grinder
- d. Cutting Blocks
- e. Meat Slicers and utensils
