GENERAL INFORMATION

1. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. TO CALL OPERATOR: Dial "O" and wait for the operator to answer.
- b. TO CALL AN EXTENSION OR NUMBER: To call a number on Takhli Air Force Base, merely dial the listed number (4 digit) for that activity.
- c. TO CALL ANOTHER BASE OR INSTALLATION: To place a call to another military installation, dial "O" and give the operator both the switchboard designation and your military precedence. Callers are not to specify the route via which a trunk call is to be made.
- d. TO CALL INFORMATION OPERATOR: For Information Operator assistance dial extension 113 to obtain a Takhli Air Force Base extension and / or listing not found in the current base directory.
- e. TRANSFERRING CALL: To recall the operator to transfer an incoming and outgoing call connected to another military installation depress the disconnect button at intervals of 2 or 3 seconds, enabling the operator to receive a recall signal on the switchboard. DO NOT depress the disconnect button in a rapid motion, for each depress of the button tends to over ride the other, therefor the operator does not receive the recall signal.
- f. Operators are prohibited to book calls into the USAF Tactical Telephone System. All calls will be handled on an individual basis according to assigned precedence. When the trunk requested is engaged on an equal or higher precedence call, the operator will inform the caller and request the call be re-initiated at a later time. Reference PACAF Regulation 100-12.

2. USE AND PRIVILEGES OF MILITARY TELEPHONE SYSTEM:

- a. TYPE OF CALLS: Only official calls will be made over military lines.
- b. PROFANITY: Use of obscene language over telephone circuits is in violation of ACP 125 (B), paragraph 102C (B) (J), and United States Code 18, Chapter 71, Article 1464 n which is quoted for your information. Quote: Broadcasting Obscene Language. Whoever utters any obscene, indecent, or profane language by means of radio communications shall be fined not more than ten thousand (\$ 10,000) dollars or imprisoned not more than two (2) years, or both. Unquote. Personnel should be made aware of possible civil action in addition to military court martial action should such an offense occur.

c. SECURITY: Telephone calls within the area, and trunk calls placed within or from the PACAF area, may be completed via radiotelephone circuit. These circuits are particularly susceptible to monitoring and interception. Telephone users must insure that information of a classified or sensitive nature is not divulged. It is particularly important that attempts are not made to circumvent classified subjects, as such attempts invariably disclose the real meaning to trained personnel.

3. JOINT UNIFORM TELEPHONE COMMUNICATIONS PRECEDENCE SYSTEM:

a. This system is applicable to all telephone communications within the Department of Defense.

b. The precedence indicators listed below are directed for joint use and specify, by military precedence designator, the relative order in which telephone calls will be handled, based on the importance (content) of the call.

c. Each precedence pre-empts calls of lower precedence. Calls of one precedence do not pre-empt calls of equal precedence except FLASH calls from (1) The President of the United States, Secretary of Defense, and The Joint Chiefs of Staff, (2) Commander of Unified and Specified Commands when declaring either Defense Condition One or Defense Emergency and CINCNORAD when declaring either Defense Condition or Air Force Emergency.

d. The following is the Military Telephone Precedence System and applications:

(1) FLASH: Flash precedence is reserved for alerts, warnings or other emergency actions having an immediate bearing on national, command or area security, e.g., Presidential use, announcement of an alert, opening of hostilities, land, air or sea catastrophies, intelligence reports on matters leading to enemy attack, potential or actual nuclear accident.

(2) IMMEDIATE: Immediate precedence is reserved for vital communications; (a) having an immediate operational effect on tactical operations; (b) which directly concern safety or rescue operations; (c) Which effect the intelligence community operational role, e.g., initial vital reports of damage due to enemy action, land, sea or air reports which must be completed from vehicles in motion such as operational mission aircraft, intelligence reports on vital actions in progress, natural disaster or widespread damage, emergency use of circuit restoration, use by tactical command posts for passing immediate operational traffic.

(3) PRIORITY: Priority precedence is reserved for calls which require prompt completion for national defense and security, the successful conduct of war or the safeguard of life or property which do not require higher precedence, e.g., reports of priority land, sea or air movement; logistic activity calls that have a serious impact on military, administrative, intelligence, operational or logistic activities if handled as a Routine Call. Normally, Priority will be the highest precedence which may be assigned to administrative matters for which speed of handling is of paramount importance.

(4) ROUTINE: Routine precedence is reserved for all other official communications.

4. PRECEDENCE OF CALLS: Calls will be placed utilizing the precedence commensurate with the subject and the circumstances involved. Each authorized user should consider whether a call requires special precedence and exercise care not to request or utilize one higher than the circumstances require. Personnel should use Routine for all official calls of an administrative nature.

5. TELEPHONE DIRECTORY: It is the responsibility of each individual or activity listed herein to promptly report any errors, changes, additions and deletions to this directory to Telephone Operations NCOIC. For your convenience the form found on the last page of this directory may be used for this purpose.

6. REQUEST FOR TELEPHONE SERVICE: Requests for service will be submitted on AF Form 1070, Telephone Service Request, in three (3) copies to the 1980th Communications Squadron (Attn DEC). Where additional lines/equipment are requested, full justification must be included in your request. Attached drawings are encouraged when request is of a complex nature.

7. REPORTING TELEPHONE TROUBLES: Telephone troubles should be reported to extension 2422. When reporting trouble please state your extension number, building number, or location and suspected trouble.

8. TELEPHONE COMPLAINTS: If a telephone operator appears inefficient or is discourteous, he or she should not be reprimanded by the subscriber as that will tend to increase the inefficiency. Instead, the operator should be requested to give his or her operator number and the matter reported to the NCOIC of Telephone Operations or the Chief Military Operator on duty, at extension 2657.

9. DURATION OF CALLS: No time limit is established for Flash or Emergency calls. All other precedence calls should be limited to five (5) minutes.

10. PHONETIC ALPHABET: The use of the phonetic alphabet is of value in pronouncing isolated letters and spelling out words that may be difficult to understand over voice communications. The following phonetic equivalent are those employed for combined joint and intra-Air Force use:

12. TELEPHONE TIPS FOR OPTIMUM SERVICE:

- a. Please call by number—This saves time.
- b. Do not "ride" the dial while initiating a call. Remove your finger as each digit is dialed, allowing the dial selector to return to its original position freely.
- c. Speak directly into the mouthpiece. Clear and distinct speech enables the operator to get the number right, the first time spoken.
- d. When you find it necessary to flash the operator, do it slowly, as fast flashing appears to be a continuous light on the switchboard.
- e. When making more than one long, distant call, hang up for a minute or so between calls. This give the operator time to receive your disconnect signal.
- f. Do not expect the operator to stay with you on long distance calls. He has other calls to answer and will come back to your call if time permits.
- g. Do not get irritated with the operator when he breaks your call for one of a higher precedence. He is only following instructions.
- h. Above all, be courteous. It is required of the operators and desired of all subscribers.
- i. Insure your telephone receiver is placed back properly on it cradle when a call has been completed.
