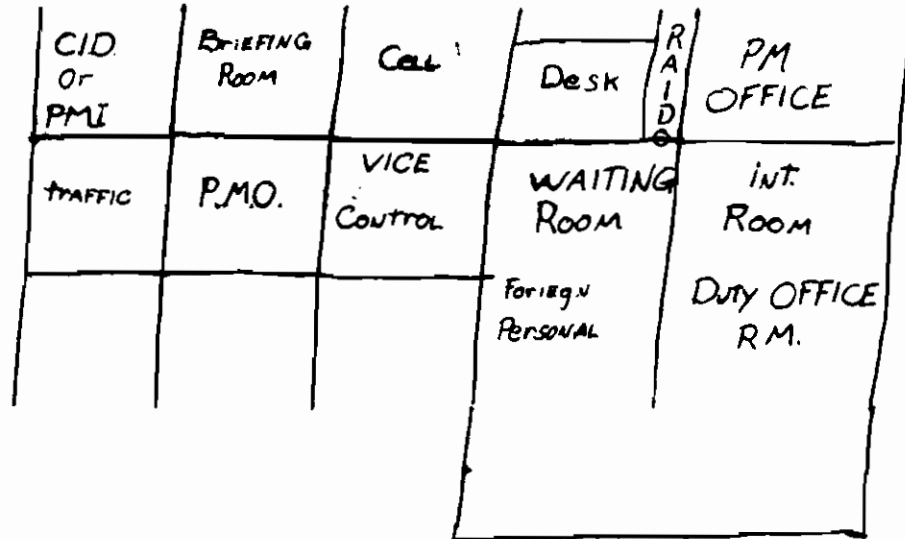

Handling Traffic Violators
