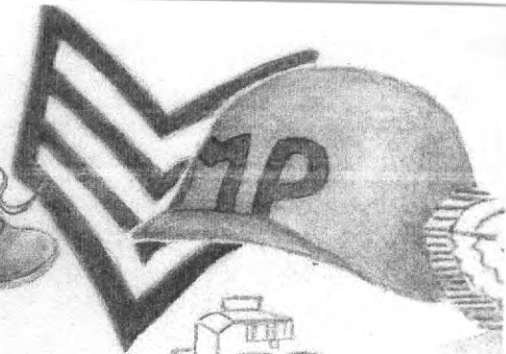
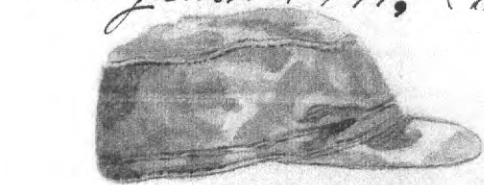


From a letter to my nieces -
