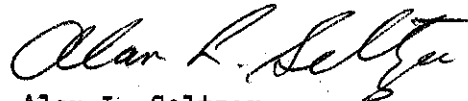

I thought I might include as a reading in this course Dr. Fishel's article of last November 2 in the New Leader, as an example of Vietnam's anti-communist nationalism. Or perhaps you have some other brief statement, for example by President Ngo Dinh Diem himself, that you feel would be suitable for presentation to undergraduates.

Thank you for your letter of May 16 regarding suitable reading materials for the course which you are preparing in "the isms".

With respect to Dr. Fishel's article, I am sorry to say that we have only a few of these remaining on hand; most of the 1000 copies we ordered originally have been distributed to our various mailing lists and to fulfill requests such as yours. You may wish to consider, however, reprinting by the photo-offset method the number of copies you require. This should be comparatively inexpensive.
