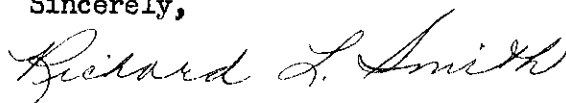
At the present time our high school is organizing a new course into our curriculum which is entitled "World Problems." The course deals with American relations with each of the following:
