1. SSgt Charles E. Harris Jr., AF19641840, is nominated for NCO of the Month for the Month of August 1968.

2. The following information is submitted in his behalf;

a. SSgt Harris has shown outstanding technical and supervisory ability in all his duty assignments. He has proven to be an extremely conscientious, efficient Airman with an outstanding knowledge of the repair functions and procedures involved in the repairing of C-7A aircraft engines. He has exerted much effort to improve himself and the accomplishment of his duties. He always seeks better methods to enable him to increase his production without a loss in quality. On many occasions he volunteered to go cross country to perform maintenance on downed aircraft at forward operating bases, some of these bases have been in very hostile areas with limited facilities. He completed the job with minimum time. He requires little or no supervision for any task to which he is assigned.

b. SSgt Harris gets along well with his fellow workers and his supervisor. He has the ability to adapt to new situations and authority that is a rare quality and seldom found in an Airman of his grade. He always accepts more than his share of the work load. He is punctual, courteous, and his personal appearance is continuously neat. He is an intelligent individual with an outstanding ability to learn and grasp pertinent details rapidly. He has a high degree of personal responsibility for the quality and quantity of work that he produces. SSgt Harris' knowledge and ability in job know how sets him apart from other NCO's. He has extensive technical knowledge of the R-2000 engine.
