



CHECK IN/CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

1. The busses that met you at Alameda will bring you to our Administrative Building (625) where your records and orders will be delivered to the Personnel Office. You will then proceed to Barracks Building 743 adjacent to the Administrative Building, and off-load your gear, receive bunk and locker assignments, and accept custody of bedding and linen. After signing for bedding and linen, return to the Personnel Office and obtain your mess pass and liberty card (E-4 and below for liberty cards). You then return to the barracks and stow your gear.
2. After you have completed the above, you may proceed on on-base or off-base liberty. Liberty expires on board at 0700, Monday through Friday for all students. Quarters at 0715 in greens. The liberty uniform is Service Dress Blue.
3. Carry out the schedule as set forth in the attached schedule sheet.
4. You will depart here on 29 October for San Diego for one week SERE training and then return to Mare Island for further training. Your records and orders will be returned to you before departure. You will be provided bus transportation to the airport for transport to San Diego. Upon your return you will be met at the airport with transportation to Mare Island.
