Subj: New Schedule for Religious Program

BANKING FACILITIES

The Bank of America has a Branch Office in Building 816, located off California and 12th Streets. Phone 644-1161, extension 287. Check cashing facilities for military personnel are open on military paydays from 1100 to 1300. One military check cashing facility is located on the USS PELIAS and another at the U.S. Naval School Command in the Canteen Building across from the U.S. Naval Schools Command Administration Building. Telephone bills may be paid at the bank. Hours Monday through Thursday, 1000 to 1500; Friday, 1100 to 1700.

CAMERAS

GENERAL

Active duty military personnel and their dependents may carry photographic equipment on and off the Shipyard. All others are required to have a camera permit. Photography is prohibited in the following areas:

- Waterfront and industrial areas
- Warehouse and storage areas
- Any posted security area

CHIEF PETTY OFFICERS' MESS - OPEN

Located in Building 41, 13th Street off Cedar, extension 4864 and 646-4232. Hours Tuesday through Thursday, 1100 to 1300 and 1600 to 2330; 1100 to 0130 Friday; 1000 to 0130 Saturday; 1300 to 2330 Sunday. GAME Night every Tuesday at 2000. Dancing every Friday and Saturday night and on other special occasions. Luncheon served 1100 to 1300 daily except Sunday and Monday. Dinner Served Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday at 1700 and Sunday beginning at 1600. Happy Hour on occasion. Package Store open 1000 to 1800 Tuesday through Saturday. Baby sitting service available Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday beginning at 1800 and on other special occasions. There is a colored T.V. in Baby Sitting Room available outside normal baby sitting hours.

CLOTHING AND SMALL STORES

Located across the street to the rear of Rodman Center. Hours Monday through Friday, 0830 to 1300 and 1400 to 1600. Closed Saturday, Sunday, and holidays and the last two working days of each quarter for inventory. Phone extension 4624. Marine Corps uniform items each military payday.

COMMISSARY STORE

Located outside the North Gate. Hours Monday, 1000 to 1500 (except meat counter closed); Tuesday and Wednesday, 1000 to 1700; Thursday and Friday, 1000 to 1800; and Saturday, 0900 to 1400. Closed Sunday and on day each quarter for inventory and all legal holidays. Inventory date will be posted in advance outside the store. Phone 642-8941 and 642-8942. Bread, milk and snack-type food is also available in the Navy Exchange Location Store located in Building M-34 on Club Drive and 13th Streets.

COMMISSIONED OFFICERS' MESS-OPEN

DRIVER'S LICENSES

Resident. California license.

Non-Resident.

1. Over 21 years of age. Can drive in California using the valid license issued by his home state, providing he maintains non-resident status.

2. Under 21 years of age. Military minors on active duty must obtain a California license or a certificate of compliance with the California Financial Law within sixty days immediately following entry into this state.

ENLISTED MEN'S CLUB

Neptune Club located in Building 753 on Walnut Avenue near North Gate, 644-6767. Hours Monday through Thursday, 1630 to 2400; Friday, 1630 to 0200; Saturday, 1200 to 0200; Sunday and holidays, 1200 to 2400. There is a snack bar where you may order food ranging from pizza to steaks to go with your beer. There is also a game room with pool and ping pong. Dancing every Friday and Saturday night to live music. Game Night Monday and Thursday at 2000. A Separate dining room and bar area is located in the Club for Petty Officer First and Second ONLY.

FIREARMS

It is necessary to have a firearm permit to bring firearms into the Shipyard. Application forms and rules for use are available at the Police Station. The Police Chief issues firearm permits. Loss of firearms will be reported immediately to the Police Station (Tel. 2493.)

FISHING

Fishing is permitted in the following authorized areas for active duty military personnel and their dependents: Berth 2. Berths 20, 21, and 22 North except during working hours, normally 0730 to 1615, Monday through Friday. Fishing is also allowed in areas occupied by the Mare Island Group Pacific Reserve Fleet. This is covered by separate instructions and the areas are Berths 22 South, 23 and 24 and fenced area south of Sears Point Bridge. A California Fishing License is required and California State Game Laws will be observed by all persons fishing in the above authorized areas.

HUNTING

Mare Island has been designated a wild life refuge and hunting or taking of game is prohibited.

NAVY RELIEF SOCIETY

The purpose of the Society is to "collect and hold funds" and to use same for aid in times of need of the officers and enlisted men in the Naval service. It also provides aid in times of need to dependents of officers and enlisted men, and provides relief and assistance to the dependents of deceased officers and men. Financial assistance may take the form of a loan without interest, an outright grant, or a combination of the two depending on consideration of all pertinent facts and circumstances in a given case. The Society has always believed that Naval men desire to develop and maintain their independence, self-reliance and financial integrity. To assist in this end, it has always been the policy of the Society to help men meet their obligations in times of emergency but not to relieve them of their responsibility to provide for themselves and their dependents insofar as they are able. Financial assistance is rendered in the form of a loan without interest which the person may repay by a small monthly allotment. Since the Society is not a Government Agency, but is supported entirely by contributions, assistance given must not be considered a benefit or a right and therefore must be limited.

The Navy Relief Society is located topside Rodman Center, Building 545, phone 644-0756. Hours Monday through Friday, 0730 to 1130 and 1230 to 1600 for payments; interviews for assistance, 0900 to 1130 and 1300 to 1600.

PARKING

Parking of vehicles on the Shipyard is permitted only in those areas or locations specifically designated for parking and so posted. When parking other than parallel, vehicles will head into designated spaces. Backing into parking spaces is authorized only in those locations which are specifically posted for such method. Parking areas posted as "MISCELLANEOUS" (MISC.) are open to all vehicles at all times. Reserved Parking. Some spaces and areas are reserved for special use and are marked or posted "Reserved". Such spaces as are designated by Number are Reserved from 0630 to 1530 on normal Shipyard work days, but are available to all vehicles at all other times. Spaces marked "24 hours" or posted a reserved by Titles are reserved at all times. PRIVATE motor vehicles within the confines of the Shipyard, and areas adjacent under the jurisdiction of the Shipyard, left unattended for a period of ten days will be considered as abandoned. Abandoned vehicles will be disposed of as property abandoned to the United States.

POST OFFICE

The Shipyard post office is located in Building 104, 625 Walnut Avenue, next to the Administration Building, extension 3364. Hours Monday through Friday, 0730 to 1600. There is also a Branch Office located in Rodman Center, 520 N. Walnut Avenue, Building 545, extension 2898. Hours Monday through Friday, 0900 to 1300 and 1330 to 1700.

The school's mail room is not authorized to conduct any postal business other than pick up and delivery of mail.

PROPERTY PASSES

No material of any kind will be removed from the Shipyard unless it is authorized by a property pass or permit signed by the proper authority except that adult member of families occupying quarters on the Shipyard may remove private property from the Shipyard without a property pass.

RECREATION FACILITIES

Morton Field. This is an illuminated field across Walnut Avenue from Rodman Center, and used for 12th Naval District and inter-command scheduled events such as football, baseball and softball.

North Gate Fields. Three softball diamonds for practice and play. Reservations for their use may be made with Special Services Office, extension 3436 or 4289. Diamond No. 3 has a Bar-B-Que pit and patio available for picnicking.

Athletic Gear Issue Room. Next to the gym in Rodman Center, Extension 2760. Monday through Friday, 1200 to 1900.

Bowling Alley. Located on the second deck in Rodman Center. Extension 3219. Monday through Friday, 1130 to 1300 and 1600 to 2200; Saturday and Sunday, 1300 to between 2200 and 2400, depending on how many people are using lanes. Ten automatic lanes.

Golf Course. An excellent 9-hole, 18-tee course located at the end of club Drive. Phone 644-3888. 0900 - Dark, Tuesday through Friday; 0800 - Dark, Saturday and Sunday. Closed Monday.

Gymnasium. Located on first floor of Rodman Center. Basketball, volleyball, badminton courts, boxing ring, showers and lockers. Extension 2760. 1200 to 2100 Monday through Friday; 1300 to 1900 Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

Hobby Shops. Located in Building H88, 17th Street and Railroad Avenue. Extension 4345. 1500 to 2200, Tuesday through Friday and 1100 to 1700, Saturday and Sunday, Automotive and Carpentry. Ceramics hours Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, 1300 to 1600 and 1800 to 2200. Greenware and molds available.

Library. Second floor of Rodman Center. 1000 to 2100, Monday through Friday, and 1300 to 2100, Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

Swimming Pool. Indoor pool located near gym in Rodman Center. Hours 1530 to 2100. Tuesday through Friday; 1300 to 1900, Saturday and Sunday; closed Monday. Call extension 2760 or 3436 for further information.

Theater. Located in Rodman Center, Building 545. Movies shown at 1730 and 2015 Monday through Saturday; Saturday, 1330 Kiddie Matinee (Free). Sunday movies shown at 1330 and 1900. Extension 3301.

Rodman Racway. Slot car sales and rental for use on Raceway in Rodman Center Building 545. Hours Monday through Friday, 1630 to 2200; Saturday, 1300 to 2200; Sunday, 1300 to 1800. Own cars can be used for a nominal track charge, call extension 2603.

Tennis Courts. Available daily, tennis equipment can be checked out from Gear Issue Room, Rodman Center. Tennis court locations are as follows: three opposite St. Peters Chapel, two adjacent to Morton field and Submarine Administrative Building, two - Nuclear Power School area, and two Marine Barracks area.

Summer Fun Program. Annually, Special Services operates a summer fun program for all military dependents ages 6 through 12. This program is operated each morning from 0900 to 1200 for a period of six weeks normally commencing from the last week in June through the first week in August. Yearly, the program offers swimming instruction, arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor games, plus field trips. For further information, call extension 3436 or 4289.

RED CROSS

The American Red Cross Field Director is located topside in the Military Dispensary, Building H73, Room 343, phone 644-7283. In emergencies after hours or on weekends, the Director can be reached by calling 644-7451 or 644-7283. Hours are from 0800 to 1600, Monday through Friday.

TRAFFIC

Maximum speed limit anywhere on the Shipyard is 30 mph; lower speed limits are posted throughout the yard. The limit varies in different areas and is normally controlled by traffic, weather and other local conditions. The maximum speed limit on the causeway is 35 mph; stopping, U turns and passenger pickup on the causeway is prohibited; changing lanes is prohibited during the one-way traffic periods; 0630 to 0730 incoming; 1600 to 1640 outgoing. During periods of rush traffic, no crossing over center line is permitted on two lane streets. On three lane streets, two lanes southbound, 0630 to 0730 and two lanes northbound, 1600 to end of rush are established.

TRAILERS

Trailers owned, leased or rented by military personnel living on the Shipyard may be brought into yard upon approval by the Shipyard Chief of Police or the Security Superintendent. Trailers will be parked only in areas designated for that purpose and at the owner's risk. Living in a trailer on the Shipyard is prohibited. Personnel will contact Police Protection Branch, Building 569, phone 646-2491 for Approval Form and parking instruction.

TRANSPORTATION

Only civilian taxis can operate onto Mare Island from the surrounding community. Transportation services of various types are offered on and off the Shipyard. For information, call 3967 or 646-4367. The following types of transportation are available:

a. Consolidated bus operating in a north/south direction on Walnut, Cedar, and Railroad Avenues on a half-hour schedule between 0600-2400 and 0000 to 0200 daily, servicing:

- (1) The Sears Point, Tennessee Street, and Naval Weapons Station Annex gates.
- (2) The Farragut and Coral Sea Village Housing Units.

b. A mule train operates along Waterfront and California Avenues from Berth 6 to 18th Street on a quarter-hour schedule 0730-1600, Monday through Friday (excepting holidays).

c. Ship to Shop Express, taxis, and radio controlled pickups operate regularly during working hours.

d. Passenger and non-passenger U-Drive equipment available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

e. Intersite bus service between Mare Island and Hunters Point daily, Monday through Friday (excepting holidays) on published schedules.

f. Church and Sunday School bus service from Roosevelt Terrace, Sears Point Gate, Pacific Reserve Fleet, Nuclear Power School and ships present to Saint Peter's Chapel and Day Care Center, 733 Cedar Avenue. Detailed information on schedule is available at extension 4367.

g. School bus transportation is furnished in accordance with schedules published at the beginning of each school year.

h. Bus service to Treasure Island departs at 0615 and 1430 and returns at 0830 and 1530, Monday through Friday (excepting holidays), for authorized military and civilian personnel on official business.

i. Jitney Service between central Vallejo points and Mare Island (throughout the Shipyard) daily, every twenty minutes from 0600 to 0800 and 1500 to 1800, and every thirty minutes from 0800 to 1500 and 1800 to 0200. Specific stops are not established and service may be obtained by hailing the Jitneys.

VEHICLE LICENSES

Resident. Anyone whose permanent place of residence is recorded as within this state. Resident must display valid California vehicle license plates.

Non-Resident. Anyone whose permanent residence is in another state. Non-Resident may display either plates issued by State of California or by the state of his home of record.

If license plates from such other states are not renewed and displayed within the valid time limit set by such other state, the non-resident loses his option and must then acquire California vehicle license. EXCEPTION: A member of the Armed Forces on active duty within the State of California may display a valid license plate from another state if issued while he was regularly stationed for duty by competent military orders in such state at the time such license was issued, except for commercial-type vehicles. When these plates expire, passenger-type vehicle licenses must be renewed in the state that is the military member's home of record or in the State of California.

VEHICLE PASSES

Passes (decals) are issued by the Badge and Pass Office, Building 569, 507 California Avenue, Monday through Friday, 0730 to 1600. All applicants are subject to the financial responsibility provisions of the California Vehicle Code. Valid vehicle registration, valid driver's license and proof of insurance (a current insurance policy or paid premium receipt) must be presented at the time of application. Minimum coverage is \$10,000 and \$20,000 for public liability and \$5,000 property damage. NOTE: Insurance written to cover "ON BASE" driving only IS NOT acceptable.
