2. Cao, Mong Long


I believe that their status under the eligiity guidelines of the Orderly Departure Progran (ODP) is affected by the McCain Amendment of the 1997 Foreign Operations Act which restores eligibility to the unmarried over-21 children of the former Vietnamese political prisoners.

I request that ODP check the case according to the case numbers provided above and confirm for me that the children listed above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate dnowing the date it was sent and to what address in Vietnam. That will help me ensure it arrives.

I appreciate that your office is busy with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the case of our chilren be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires.

On behalf of my family, I thank you for your help in this matter.

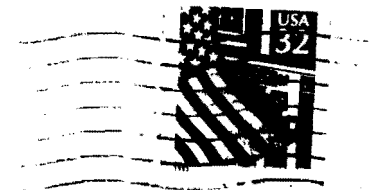
