I am writing on behalf of my children:

1. An Quang Lam, DOB: 17 Oct 1973, single, address: 119 To 27, Phuong 10, Lac Long Quan Street, Quan Tan Binh, HOCHIMINH City, Vietnam;
2. Thanh Tuyen Thi Lam, DOB: 15 April 1958, single, same address as above;

I believe that their status under the eligibility guidelines of the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) is affected by the McCain Amendment of the 1997 Foreign Operation Act which restores eligibility to the unmarried over-21 sons and daughters of the former Vietnamese political prisoners.

I request that ODP check the cases according to the case numbers provided above and eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date it was sent and to what address in Vietnam. That will help me ensure it arrives.

I appreciate that your office is busy with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the case of our children be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires. On behalf of my family, I thank you for your help in this matter.
