I am writing on behalf of my daughter: TRINH-VIET-MY
I believe that her status under the eligibility guidelines of
the Orderly Departure Program ODP is affected by the McCain
Amendment of the 1997 Foreign Operation Act which restores
eligibility to the unmarried over 21 sons and daughters of the
former Vietnamese political prisoners

I request that ODP check the case according to the case numbers
provided above and confirm for me that the daughter listed
above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now
contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction
has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date
it was sent and to what address in Viet Nam. That will help
me insure it arrives. I appreciate that your office is busy
with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to
ensure that the case of our children be reconsidered under
the new law before their eligibility expires.

On behalf my family, I thank you for your help in this
matter.

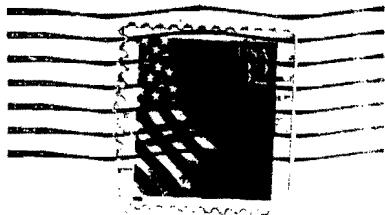
