I am writing on behalf of my children,

- DANG DUC HIEU - DOB: November 10th, 1969 Male
- DANG HIEU NGHIA - DOB: November 08th, 1970 Male
- DANG THI NGOC THAO - DOB: July 20th, 1974 Female

All three of them are living in 259/10 Su Van Hanh St. Hoc Mi City

I believe that their status under the eligibility guidelines of the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) is affected by the McCain Amendment of the 1997 Foreign Operation Act which restores eligibility to the unmarried over-21 sons and daughter of the former Vietnamese political prisoners.

I request that ODP check the cases according to case number provided above and confirm for me that the sons and daughter listed above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date it was sent and to what address in Vietnam. That will help me ensure it arrives.

I appreciate that your office is busy with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the cases of our children be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires.

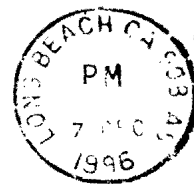
On behalf of my family, I thank you for your help in this matter.
