Dear Mr. PENDERGRASS :

I am writing on behalf of my childrens :

1/- DANG PHI HUNG DOB : Jan. 20 - 1970 Male

2/- DANG TO TRANG DOB : May 12 - 1974 Female

All two of them are living at Dong Thanh Chamlet, Dong Thanh village. Binh Minh district. Vinh Long province South Vietnam.

I believe that their status under eligibility guidelines of the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) is affected by the McCain Amendment of the 1997 Foreign Operation Act which restores eligibility to the unmarried over-21 son and daughter of the former Vietnamese political prisoners.

I request that ODP check the cases according to case number provided above and confirm for me that the son and daughter listed above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date it was sent and to what address in Vietnam. That will help me ensure it arrives.

I appreciate that your office is busy with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the cases of our children be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires.
