



1. Pursuant to the authority contained in DA MSC OD FMT/4202394 from DCSOPS, dated 17 May 1962, the above named individuals, members of the Army of the Republic of Vietnam, are authorized and invited to proceed OA 20 Nov 62 from their present duty stations to the Continental United States arriving at Travis AFB, California for the purpose of attending the Small Arms Repair Course 9-R-421.1, reporting 30 Nov 62 ending (subject to change) 15 Feb 63 at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland. Upon completion of this training, they will return to their home stations.

2. The individuals listed herein will report upon arrival in the United States to the Commanding General, Ft Mason, California who will issue a transportation request for travel to Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland. Upon completion of this training, the above named individuals will return to Fort Mason, California for return to Vietnam.

3. Travel by privately owned conveyance is not authorized. Exception to this policy may be granted in accordance with Section V, AR 551-50. No dependants will accompany students, be transported or maintained at MAP expense.

4. Commercial air or surface transportation is authorized only if government transportation is not available. Extra fare aircraft authorized. Circuitous travel not authorized.

5. If the individuals listed herein encounter any difficulty in arranging transportation after arrival in CONUS, they will contact the Transportation Movement Headquarters Ft Mason, S-3 (Opns) JIN Allied Liaison Branch, Fort Mason, California, Telephone Prospect 6-2200, Extension 3162.

6. The government of the United States absolves itself from any blame or financial responsibility for injuries received by the individuals listed herein while in transit or undergoing training and any responsibility for any personal or property damage claim resulting from their actions.

7. Prior to departure from their present duty stations, the individuals listed herein will be required to be medically examined and found physically acceptable in accordance with the health provisions of the Immigration Nationality Act (McCarran Act), (Sec. 212A, 1-7 PL 414 32d Cong) and Foreign Quarantine Regulations of Public Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, 42. CFR, part 71. The country concerned will provide the individuals concerned with sufficient funds in American dollar instrument to meet all expenses while enroute to and for the first 15 days at the school. Adequate uniforms as well as appropriate civilian clothing for off duty wear should be taken. United States work (fatigue) uniforms, less distinctive insignia, are required for field wear or technical work.

8. The United States will relieve from attendance at the Schools and request their return to the country of their origin, students who violate regulations or who otherwise are a detriment to the class as a whole. The Military Attache in Washington, of the country concerned, will be informed through Department of the Army Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations when such actions is contemplated.

9. Individuals named herein are authorized to transport one hundred(100) pounds of personal baggage to the United States, which will accompany personnel. An additional fifty (50) pounds of instructional material is authorized for return from the United States to Vietnam. The fifty (50) pounds of instructional material will be shipped by Military Air Freight. Under no circumstances will baggage, which is in excess of the above weight allowance be transported at MAP expense.

10. Request for leave upon completion of the course will be submitted direct by the individuals to their Military Attache in Washington, D. C. Written approval from the Military Attache to the individuals will constitute approval for leave. Leave per diem will be paid in accordance with paragraph 40, change 5, AR 551-50, not to exceed seven days.

11. Per diem authorized while in the United States will be in accordance with Section V, AR 551-50. Travel and per diem expenses are chargeable to 21-1131080-771 384-9010 P4120-21-22 592-112 and CIC 2/03/1080/771/92112. The Finance Officer effecting disbursement of funds under this authority will forward one copy of the executed voucher to MAAG, Vietnam.

12. No training other than that specified in paragraph 1 above will be conducted on the basis of these orders. If additional training or circuitous travel is desired the individuals concerned will submit request therefore directly to representatives of their government for forwarding through the channels prescribed in paragraph 17 and 18, AR 551-50.

13. The mailing address of the individuals indicated herein will be in care of the Army installation to which they are attached.
