- 3- May 1st 1977 he had been removed to re-education camp located Cambodian Vietnamese border box N° 7590 HT/L6/T3 T2 block 10.

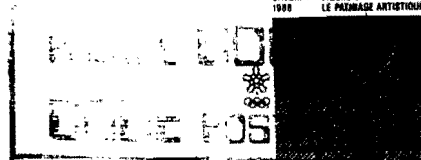

I hope to have a peaceful life in the days come.
