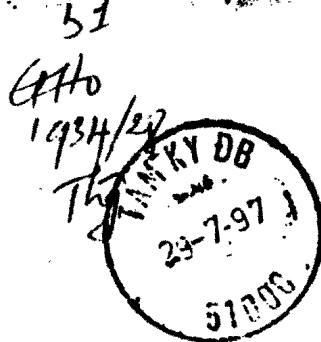
Kính thưa Bà.
