
Dear Mr. Huynh:

Dear Sir/Madam:

This is in response to your inquiry concerning the United States Orderly Departure Program, a program by which qualified individuals are able to resettle in the United States from Vietnam. The high volume of ODP cases and inquiries unfortunately prevent our giving you a more formal response than this letter.

- We regret that the Orderly Departure Program policy prohibits responses to inquiries from any party other than the petitioner, a very close relative of the beneficiary in Vietnam, or the petitioner's representative designated in writing on Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) Form G-28.
- We acknowledge receipt of the documents for Nguyen Dang Dinh, IV No. 529170, which you sent us on 23 Jan 87. We have not reviewed your relative's/relatives' files. File review is conducted in accordance with an established schedule of priorities. If additional documents are needed, we shall contact you after the file has been reviewed.
- The documents which we still need to complete _____'s case are: _____

- The Letter of Introduction (LOI) which you are inquiring about has/had not been issued. The LOI does not guarantee that you/your relative(s) will receive exit permission, as that must be obtained from the Vietnamese authorities.
- Should you/your relative(s) receive an exit permit, please notify ODP of the exit permit numbers for each person listed on the case.
- The interview with the UNHCR representative in Ho Chi Minh City has not been conducted. Interviews are scheduled by the Vietnamese authorities, and we have no influence on the scheduling of individual cases for interview.
- Your relative(s) has/had been interviewed in Ho Chi Minh City, but his/her/their case has not yet been approved by a Consular or INS officer.
- We are awaiting a medical clearance for your relative(s).
- Your relative(s) has/had been approved for the U.S., and we have notified the Vietnamese that he/she/they may be placed on a manifest for departure. We cannot predict when he/she/they will be manifested as that is solely up to the Vietnamese authorities. A local voluntary agency in your area will notify you of your relative's/relatives' onward travel plans and his/her/their exact date of arrival in the United States.

This Service will be unable to answer any inquiry concerning visa issuance.*
- IF YOU BECOME NATURALIZED AS A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES AND AN IMMIGRANT VISA HAS NOT YET BEEN ISSUED TO THE BENEFICIARY, NOTIFY THIS OFFICE IMMEDIATELY, GIVING THE DATE OF YOUR NATURALIZATION. AT THE SAME TIME, IF THE PETITION WAS IN BEHALF OF YOUR SON OR DAUGHTER, ALSO ADVISE WHETHER THAT PERSON IS STILL UNMARRIED. THIS INFORMATION MAY EXPEDITE THE ISSUANCE OF A VISA TO THE BENEFICIARY.
- YOUR PETITION FOR PREFERENCE CLASSIFICATION, AS SHOWN ABOVE, HAS BEEN FORWARDED TO THE UNITED STATES CONSULATE AT BANGKOK. THIS COMPLETES ALL ACTION BY THIS SERVICE ON THE PETITION. THIS SERVICE HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH THE ACTUAL ISSUANCE OF VISAS. VISAS ARE ISSUED ONLY BY UNITED STATES CONSULS WHO ARE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE. UNDER THE LAW ONLY A LIMITED NUMBER OF VISAS MAY BE ISSUED BY THAT DEPARTMENT DURING EACH YEAR AND THEY MUST BE ISSUED STRICTLY IN THE CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER IN WHICH PETITIONS WERE FILED FOR THE SAME CLASSIFICATION. WHEN THE BENEFICIARY'S TURN IS REACHED ON THE VISA WAITING LIST, THE UNITED STATES CONSUL WILL INFORM HIM AND CONSIDER ISSUANCE OF THE VISA. *Inquiry concerning visa issuance should be addressed to the Consul. This Service will be unable to answer any inquiry concerning visa issuance.*
- THE PETITION STATES THAT THE BENEFICIARY IS IN THE UNITED STATES AND WILL APPLY TO BECOME A LAWFUL PERMANENT RESIDENT. THE ENCLOSED APPLICATION FOR THIS PURPOSE (FORM I-485) SHOULD BE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED BY THE BENEFICIARY WITHIN 30 DAYS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTRUCTIONS CONTAINED THEREIN (IF THE BENEFICIARY HAD PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED FORM I-485 WHICH WAS RETURNED TO HIM, HE SHOULD RESUBMIT THAT FORM WITHIN 30 DAYS.)
- THE BENEFICIARY WILL BE INFORMED OF THE DECISION MADE ON HIS PENDING APPLICATION TO BECOME A LAWFUL PERMANENT RESIDENT (FORM I-485).
- THE PETITION STATES THAT THE BENEFICIARY IS IN THE UNITED STATES AND WILL APPLY TO BECOME A LAWFUL PERMANENT RESIDENT. HOWEVER, AN IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER IS NOT PRESENTLY AVAILABLE. THEREFORE, THE BENEFICIARY MAY NOT APPLY TO BECOME A PERMANENT RESIDENT.
