Vietnamese Political Prisoners.

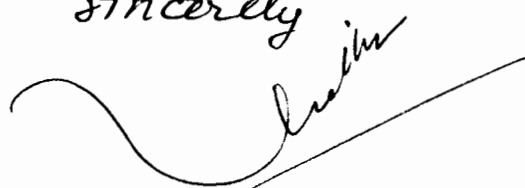
I Request that ODP check The case according to case number provided above and confirm for me that the daughters and my wife listed above are eligible - and the part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent.

That will help me ensure it arrives. I appreciate that your office is busy with many cases. But my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the case of our children be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires.
