Before April 1975, I was a Second Lieutenant, Phan Shik Khu Phu, xã Hòa Bình, Thành, chánh,
in the armed forces of the Republic of Vietnam (in the government of the Republic of
Vietnam). After the communists came to power, I was imprisoned in a re-education camp
from (6.1.21/1975) to (8.1.3.0/1980) Đầm Lác Sông, Hồng Cát Đồng Tháp, Tân Höhe, Chí Hòa

Because of that experience I have been admitted to the United States on
7.1.14.1.1995 in accordance with a subprogram of the Oderly Departure Program for
former political
prisoners under a bilateral agreement between Vietnam and the United States. While I
am greatful for the chance to resettle in the United States, my resettlement has been
made extremely difficult because the following unmarried chilren of mine have been
rejected for resettlement despite the fact that for many years unmarried children were
permitted to
accompany their parents who were former political prisoners.

family now continues to be split at a time when we thought that we could be reunited.
