

I request that ODP check the case (s) according to the case numbers and confirm for me that the son(s) or daughter(s) listed above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date on which it was sent to whom and what address in Vietnam. This will help me ensure its safety.

I appreciate the fact that your office is busy with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the case of our children be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires.
