I believe that their status under the eligibility guidelines of the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) is effected by restore eligibility the unmarried over 21 sons and daughter of the former Vietnamese political prisoners.

I request that ODP check the case of my two sons according to the case number and confirm for me that my two sons listed above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date it was sent and to what address in Vietnam. That will help me ensure it arrives.
