My name is HOAN HONG LUU, a former political prisoner of Vietnamese Communist regime. I am currently residing at 5, telephone number

Before April 1975, I was a lieutenant in the armed forces of the republic of Sud Vietnam. After the Communists came to power, I was imprisoned in a re-education Camp from 3/11/75 to 11/2/80 at A-30 Phú Khánh, Vietnam.

Because of that experience, I have been admitted to the United States on 11/14/95 in accordance with a Subprogram of the CDP program for former political prisoners under a bilateral Agreement between Vietnam and the United States. While I am grateful for the chance to resettle in the United States, my resettlement has been made extremely difficult on account of the fact that the following unmarried children of mine have been rejected for resettlement despite the fact that for many years the unmarried children were permitted to accompany their parents who were former political prisoners:

- 1) LƯU KIM KHANH
- 2) LƯU KIM THANH

Thus, I hope that you can help me so that our family could together again. In particular, may I that you give your support to Section 595 of the Foreign Operations Appropriation Bill H.R.3540 offered by Senator John McCain and enacted by the Senator on July 26, 1996. The Bill will be considered by the Conference Committee in early September, 1996. By making sure that this Section remain in the final Act, you will be helping many families of former Vietnamese political prisoners who are in the same bad situation as mine. Many, many thanks for your kind assistance.
