

"Vietnamese citizen".
Subj : Wholehearted request for salvation out of Vietnam.

Dear Sirs.,

I'd like to open this letter of mine with a brief explanation for the reason why it hasn't reached your office till now for nearly ten years since the Communists took over South Vietnam. The main problem is that I mostly served with US Intel. agencies such as MACV, USAID Region III nqs., supervised then by Mr. David. E. Brown in 1965, afterwards with III Corps National Police Advisors (Col. RUMPH, Maj. Sharidan, both MI Officers...etc...) in 1968, and next with III CTZ RUMCC (Regional Intel Operation Combined Center) advised by Col. Hamlin, and finally with Phoenix Program Provincial Recon. Unit Force as Chief of Staff for Reg.3. advised by Mr. Tucker Gouglemann (lately deceased as far as I was informed). Such a letter as this, consequently, hasn't been put into practice until now. After my resignation with RVN Force in 1972, I did work for Mr. Robert WALL for a short period of time; B.B. WALL was then Chief of the "Safe House" in Bien Hoa Province Capital.

Sir,


This letter would never have arrived at your office if I hadn't been informed by one of my (closest) friends of mine of a "special line". The whole thing is that I wrote an ordinary letter and took it to the Central Post Office to have it stamped; then instead of mailing it I brought home the letter, undoing it and wrote this additional one in English and later re-enveloped it to be mailed directly to the States from TSN Air Base without being censored thanks to the help of a friend of mine who's luckily been given a job in the "luggage carrying section" on the Tan Son Nhut Air Base.

At present I have no "to whom it may concern" papers merely because they've been destroyed since the former Government was overthrown. I wholeheartedly beg you to take pity on my family by having my background crosschecked to save my whole family out of Vietnam as soon as it is verified. I'm presently leading an extremely needy life just because I've received no official jobs from the Gov't and moreover, spent most of my properties for bordercrossing runaways in vain.

I am greatly hopeful my dream will soon come true in order for me to contribute the whole rest of my life to such a freedom country as yours.
