Dear Sir/Madam:

We have forwarded copies of your relative(s)' Exit Permits to the ODP Office in Bangkok.

Under current procedures, once the ODP Office is made aware that Exit Permits have been issued to persons in Vietnam a file review will be conducted. If it is determined on the basis of case documentation that your relatives are probably eligible for entry to the U.S. and if your file is not complete, the ODP Office will send you a request for additional documents or information before a decision or acceptance can be made.

Eventually, the Vietnamese authorities may provide permission to the applicants to attend an interview conducted by the UNHCR and will arrange for medical examinations. Keep in mind, however, that it is the Vietnamese authorities who make this determination of who may actually be interviewed.

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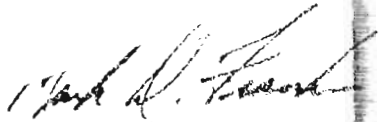
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
