Two weeks ago I received a letter from the US Embassy in Manila suggesting that I write to you on behalf of my wife, Ha Thi Hai, PS 4452. She is now in Palawan First Asylum Camp, awaiting the review of her case by the Appeal Boards.

I would like to respectfully submit my request to you to help reunite me with my wife.

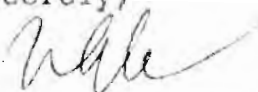
I met my wife in Palawan Camp in 1990. We moved in to live together in late 1990. We, however, could not get married till much later because my ex-wife did not send me the certificate of divorce. After being screened in and transferred to Bataan, I contacted my son in Vietnam and requested for a copy of the certificate. In the meantime, the UNHCR allowed me to file an engagement contract but told me to delay the marriage until UNHCR's verification of my divorce in Vietnam.

In late 1992, the certificate came. The US Immigration and Naturalization Service delayed my departure to the United States in an attempt to let my wife join me. However, after three months, there was still no decision on her appeal and I had to go to the United States. (Enclosed is the handwritten note of the INS officer.)

I plead to you to expedite the process and allow my wife to join me. Your humanitarian intervention will be greeted with deep gratitude on my part and on the part of my wife. My life has been so sorrowful for the past 18 years. My wife is now my only hope and joy.

I eagerly await your kind response.

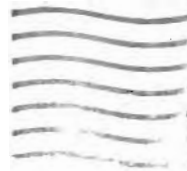
