Respectfully comes to your high benevolence and consideration by addressing the present request as it's following:

As in the period of pre 1975, I was a N.C.O. of the Engineering Corps of the Army of the Republic of South Vietnam, Serial No: 59 / 200.615, commissioned at the 7th REGIMENT of CONSTRUCTIVE ENGINEERING CORPS. at CAN THO. When the April event 1975. happened, I was arrested on May 4th 1975. as political prisoner then released on November 28th 1975. Besides, I have been trained in the USA. at the UNITED STATES ENGINEER SCHOOL at FORT BELVOIR, VIRGINIA in 1968. Certified by US. LT. COLONEL SEDNEY P. KILLESEW. I have strictly collaborated with the US advisor such as MAJOR JAMES A. WEST. who had particularly scored highly my work then.

With the Orderly departure Program, I have mailed to Bangkok since November 1984 my application. for, but regretfully till now I have not received any informations about it.

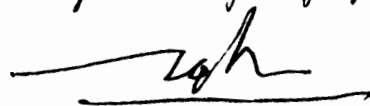
