Before April 1975, I was a Da'uy.Dai.D.S.Truong.. in the armed forces of the Repulic of Vietnam. After the Communists came to power, I was imprisoned in a re-education camp from April.6..1975 to June.21..1981..

Because of that experience I have been admitted to the United States on December.5..1995..... in accordance with a subprogam of the ODP progam, for former political prisoners under a bilateral Agreement between Vietnam and the United States. While I am grateful for the chance to resettle in the United States, my resettlement has been made extrmely diffcult on account of the fact that the following unmarried chidren of mine have been rejected for resettlement despite the fact that for many years the unmarried chidren were permitted to accompany their parents who were former political prisoners.


