Dear Senator Charles Wilson,

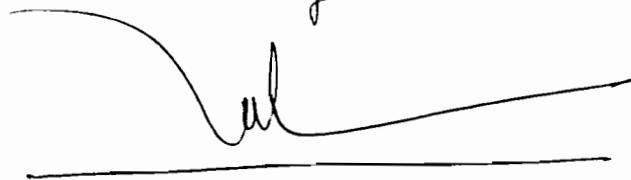
My name is NGUYEN VAN TUC, date of birth Sept. 2 - 1935, a former political prisoner of the Vietnamese communist regime, I am currently residing at

Before April 1975, I was a lieutenant police in the government of the Republic of Vietnam. After the communists came to power, I was imprisoned in a re-education camp from 27-6-75 to 9-4-82 camp Xuyen Moc.

Because of that experience I have been admitted to the United States on 23-6-95 in accordance with a subprogram of the ODP program for former political prisoners under a bilateral Agreement between Vietnam and the United States. While I am grateful for the chance to resettle in the United States, my resettlement has been made extremely difficult on account of the fact that the following unmarried children of mine have been rejected for resettlement despite the fact that for many years the unmarried children were permitted to accompany their parents who were former political prisoners.
