I undersigned Phan Kim Hoàng, widow of Thái Văn Lâm would appreciate your high consideration on my case as follows.

My husband, Mr. Thái Văn Lâm, was a officer of the former Government in South Vietnam. He was sacrificed his life in the fight against VC force in Nhơn Trạch District Biên Hòa sector on January 4th 1973. Since then, I has been a widow to feed our three children by myself. Before April - 30th 1975, I still got some supports from the former Government monthly, so, my children and I had a comparatively easy life, but, after the South was occupied by family, like other former officers' families, has been facing a lot of difficulties on all aspects: social, economic and politic on account of our close relation with the Former GVN.

At the present time, in spite of trouble, I manage to take care of my three children with hardness. Recently, I have heard that the US Government, with the agreement of Vietnam Government, will allow all former officers together with their families to settle in USA, I hurriedly present you this application with the hope to be settled in USA through your orderly departure program. I hope that although my husband was dead, my family will be accepted, too.

Besides being a widow, I am also less fortunate than

the others because, among my three children, the eldest was blind as he was born. My daughter has just finished high school but she can't go through college or university due to her father's records, an former officer.

In general, my situation is quite disappointed and becomes worse and worse. I don't care for myself but I can't help thinking of my children's future, therefore, I eagerly ask for your help and, hopeless situation by permitting us to join the ODP to move to USA for a new life full of hopes.

I'd like to get your special considerations on my family's situation and approve my request. My children and myself would be, forever, in debt to your help.
