case

Dear Sir:

I have received a letter from the Orderly Departure Program in Bangkok, Thailand informing that my case file has been transferred to the INS District Office in Bangkok, Thailand.

I am therefore sending this letter to request you to review my case as explained below:

I am a former US Government employee worked for the US Air Force in Danang Air Base from 28 November 1967 to 7 February 1973.(a copy of employment verification attached).

In October 1992, I and my two children were interviewed by the US INS interviewing official in Ho Chi Minh City and I was informed that my refugee application admission to the US was denied and I was only granted special entry to the US under PIP Program that means I must have a direct relative living in the US acting as sponsor. At that time, my brother, Pham Ngoc Son, born in 1942, a HO applicant resettled in the US on 31 July 1991, was unable to do so due to lack of financial capacity. After 1975, I have been a special political subject to be oppressed by the local authorities. In 1976, I and my family was forced to go to the new-economic zone in Hoa Trung Village. After 6 years living in the new-economic zone, in 1982, I and my family were ordered to returned to my locality (former residence address: House group 51, Area 4, Tam Thuan Ward).

In accordance with the INA, I hereby assert that I am within a category established under the Lautenberg Amendment and for this reason I believe that I may be eligible for resettlement in the US as refugee. Your reconsideration given to my case is appreciated.
