This man states that if he can get a letter from his american friends stating either or both will say that he worked for the U.S. Government and them from 1966 to 1972, he will be able to leave Viet Nam.

Phan Van Y has given two american names in his letter. 1. Capt. Robert D. Clercq? 2. Mr. Parker (civilian personel officer). It looks like Parker may be in Personel Records Center in St. Louis, Mo. Both men were assigned to Cam Ranh Bay in 1966-1972.

An ID# 00652234 is mentioned in the letter, but it is unknown at this time, who the number belongs to.

The letter states that this is an emergency letter for the man in Viet Nam.

I am writing these letter entries in this manner because the handwriting is almost unreasonable.

Please see attached translation of this letter.

Advise me at my office as to what we can do to assist this man.

I only have to take care of the papers. The problem is that in order to go quickly, I need money to make these services quicker and easier; the last service is health check • and • until you sit on the airline, then everything is safe.

Right now, I can only come to you. I have a friend in V.N., but she can only help to a certain extent. I guess I will have to wait until the harvest season.

All my applications are complete except that I'm missing a letter • proving that I have work for the U.S. government. I have lost all my papers in 1975.

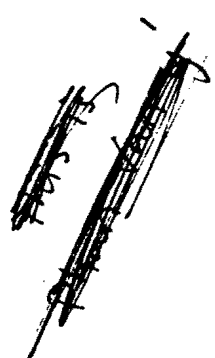
I have two addresses below that can provide me with what I need. I have ~~to~~ send them my requesting letters, but have no answers.
