We understand that your office is so busy with many cases, but our family and I are equally anxious to ensure the case (s) of our child / children is / are reconsidered under the new law before its expiration.

Thank you very much for your time and we are looking forward to hearing from you soon.

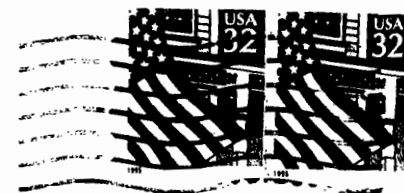
