I am writing on behalf of my children :

- To THI KIM HANH - Jan. 16, 1956 - DAUGHTER - SINGLE.
- To NGUYEN TO PHUONG - Sep. 26, 1967 - DAUGHTER - SINGLE.
- To NGUYEN VU - May 15, 1971 - Son - SINGLE.
- To HUYEN TO NHU - Jul. 03, 1974 - DAUGHTER - SINGLE. (Has 1 daughter: NGUYEN THI TRUC PHUONG - 2 year old - Her daughter now living with her boyfriend)

I believe that their status under the eligibility guidelines of the Orderly Departure Program (ODP) is affected by the Mc Cain Amendment of the 1997 Foreign Operation Act which restores eligibility to the unmarried over-21 sons and daughters of the former Vietnamese political prisoners.

I request that ODP check the case according to case number provided above and confirm for me that the sons and daughters listed above are eligible and part of the group that ODP is now contacting to invite to interview. If a new letter of introduction has already been sent, I would appreciate knowing the date it was sent and to what address in Vietnam. That will help me ensure it arrives.

I appreciate that your office is busy with many cases, but my family and I are equally anxious to ensure that the case of our children be reconsidered under the new law before their eligibility expires.

On behalf of my family, I thank you for your help in this matter.

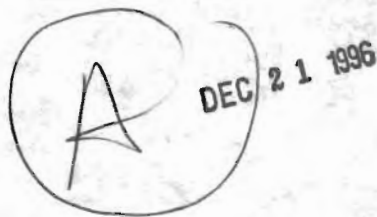
